



## **Summary of Wright Consultation Group Meeting 2 – Sunday 4 June**

Representatives of the Wright community and the Public Housing Renewal Taskforce (the Taskforce) met to further discuss the proposed public housing development on part of Block 1 Section 29 Wright. Participants represented the Wright Residents' Group and Weston Creek Community Council. An independent community engagement practitioner facilitated the meeting.

The meeting reviewed the outcomes of the previous meeting. The Wright community representatives confirmed that the capacity to adequately accommodate appropriate community facilities on the site continues to be the key issues for the broader community.

The Taskforce provided information to the meeting about the future land release program for community facilities on the site and discussed possible plans for that site. The community representatives confirmed that parking and traffic were also significant issues. They expressed interest in understanding the more detailed design of the housing units to understand implications for privacy and solar orientation.

### **Outcomes**

- The Taskforce will prepare a new site drawing and supporting description presenting the option for community facilities on the site.
- The community representatives will seek broader community feedback on this option. This may include hosting a community meeting.
- The Taskforce will ask a representative from ACT Roads to attend a future meeting with this group to discuss parking and traffic in the area.
