As residents and home owners at [REDACTED], Narrabundah, Canberra we are strongly objecting to the above referred EIS in regard to the Fyshwick Material Waste Facility proposal.

This major project with its scale and function is totally unsuitable to operate at the proposed site, with its close proximity to housing, residents and local business operating in the area.

The EIS does not sufficiently take into account the following very detrimental impacts with this proposal at this inappropriate site.

The odour from the fumes drawn up six storey high chimneys will very badly impact on residents in the old Narrabundah area.

The health risks are not adequately dealt with in the EIS. In particular the air inversion issue for this inner south area and the diesel fumes from a large constant number of vehicles on single lanes through Ipswich street in Fyshwick.

The EIS does not adequately take account of the very adverse impact of the greatly increased articulated and B Double vehicles accessing and leaving the site each day.

The impact on existing business in terms of significantly decreasing their viability and devaluing their assets. This will lead to unemployment and will "hollow out" a very vibrant business district in Canberra. This proposal will also lead to property devaluations in Narrabundah and surrounding suburbs.

The EIS does not adequately take into account the noise to residents in adjoining suburbs, particularly in old Narrabundah, from the early morning and late evening operations at the site.

We are also concerned with the fire risk associated with this proposal and how this dealt with in the EIS.

The EIS does not acknowledge the very real risk to the wetlands in the area and in particular does not provide an adequate hydrological assessment.

We are very concerned that if stage 1 of this proposal is approved the next development will lead to the establishment of a waste to energy / incinerator. This would be disastrous for the area in terms of health impacts to residents.
