I wish to lodge an objection to the proposed Fyshwick waste facility.

There can be no question that the consequent traffic congestion would be impossible to manage successfully.

The planned facility, on the scale envisaged, is completely inappropriate in this densely built-up and serviced area, and the odours emitted would cause widespread objection.

I assume that the need for such a facility has been triggered by the limited remaining life of the Mugga Lane tip. So a solution has to be found.

It is essential that the new facility be sited well away from any built-up area. Surely there must be land available somewhere near the rail line in the open spaces between Canberra and Queanbeyan.
