To Whom It May Concern,

I am writing to submit my feedback regarding DPA-14, which proposes to allow a "recycling facility" and "bulk landscape supplies" on Belconnen Block 1653.

While I support having green waste infrastructure in the ACT, making these heavy commercial uses permanent on this site raises several serious concerns:

- **Bushfire Risk:** Large stockpiles of dry mulch and organic green waste create a major fire hazard. In hot, windy weather, these sites pose a severe bushfire and spot-fire risk to the surrounding area. Any future use must require strict fuel-load limits and dedicated on-site fire suppression systems.
- **Traffic Safety:** Operating a permanent commercial recycling and landscape supply yard will significantly increase heavy truck movements. The local road network is not designed for this type of sustained commercial traffic alongside regular commuters.
- **Local Amenity:** Large-scale green waste processing generates significant dust, noise, and odour. Strong, mandatory buffer zones and environmental controls must be locked in before any approvals are granted.
- **Planning Precedent:** Expanding the allowable uses under the Belconnen District Policy sets a bad precedent. Future developments on this block must require strict, independent environmental and traffic assessments, rather than getting a blanket pass.

I ask that the Authority requires comprehensive bushfire management plans and traffic impact studies before finalising this amendment.

Dear Planning Team,

I am writing to lodge my submission regarding Draft Plan Amendment 14 and to express my concerns about the potential for the temporary Ginninderry Green Waste Facility to become a permanent operation.

After attending the recent community information meeting at The Link, I came away with several significant concerns.

Firstly, I am concerned about the fire risk associated with stockpiled green waste. I understand that green waste can become highly combustible, and the prevailing north-westerly winds during summer have the potential to carry a fire directly towards surrounding residential areas. Given the increasing population in Ginninderry and neighbouring suburbs, this is a serious public safety concern that should not be underestimated.

Secondly, I am concerned about the potential for odour from composting green waste. Large stockpiles naturally generate heat and decompose over time, creating unpleasant smells that can affect the quality of life for nearby residents and neighbouring landowners.

I am also mindful of the long-established farming family who have lived and worked adjacent to the proposed site for many decades. Their interests and ability to continue operating should be carefully considered in any planning decision.

Perhaps my greatest concern is the traffic impact. Drake Brockman Drive already experiences congestion, particularly for motorists attempting to turn onto it from Holt and Higgins during busy periods. Introducing a permanent green waste facility would significantly increase heavy vehicle movements and general traffic, worsening delays, reducing road safety, and affecting the daily lives of residents.

For these reasons, I respectfully ask that the ACT Government does not amend the planning controls in a way that would facilitate a permanent green waste facility at this location. I believe an alternative site with

fewer impacts on surrounding communities should be identified.

Thank you for considering my submission. I appreciate the opportunity to provide feedback and hope these concerns are given careful consideration during the assessment process.

As a resident close to the proposed green waste facility on Stockdill Drive I am strongly opposed to the creation of a facility of this type in the area. This is an area, previous to the construction of residential housing that has already suffered bushfires. The establishment of a green waste facility would significantly increase the potential combustion load should extreme heat and fire conditions occur. This would place houses in close proximity at considerable fire risk as well as the newly established primary school. The odours from the facility would also distribute to the residential areas and school, significantly causing and potentially creating health issues for young children in the areas, as well as those already with respiratory issues.

Traffic using Pro Hart Ave is already starting to strain with congestion due to growth in the area and it is the only road in and out of the area. Increasing the traffic load further would cause considerable issues to locals which planners for the green waste facility and the government do not seem to care about at all. This is also going to be massively impacted by the further increase in housing in Macnamara as well as the completion of the primary school and proposed retail precinct further along Pro Hart Ave. Locating a green waste facility so close to a residential and school area is completely ridiculous, inconsiderate to residents and dangerous, especially given other potential sites pose less environmental and health risks.

Dear Planning Team,

I am writing to lodge my objection to the proposal that could allow the temporary green waste facility to become a permanent facility under Draft Plan Amendment 14.

My family and I live in the surrounding area, and I am deeply concerned about the potential impacts this facility could have on our health, safety, and quality of life.

My concerns include:

1. The increased risk of fire associated with large stockpiles of green waste, particularly during the hot, dry summer months. Given the prevailing north-west winds, any fire could pose a serious risk to nearby homes and residents.
2. The odours generated by composting green waste, which could significantly reduce the amenity of surrounding neighbourhoods and affect residents' wellbeing.
3. The substantial increase in traffic along Drake Brockman Drive, creating congestion, making daily travel more difficult, and potentially increasing safety risks for motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians.
4. The impact on nearby families and long-established rural properties that have coexisted peacefully with the surrounding environment for many years.

Residents chose to live in this community because of its clean environment and family-friendly character. A permanent green waste facility is not compatible with the long-term vision for a growing residential area.

I respectfully ask that the ACT Government carefully consider the concerns of local residents and reject any proposal that would make this facility permanent. Please seek alternative locations that are better suited to this type of operation and further away from established and developing residential communities.
