We are writing as concerned Canberra citizens, having lived in the Inner South for over 50 years and now residing in Barton.

We have seen Canberra grow into a very beautiful, clean, progressive and vibrant city and mostly we are pleased with its development.

However, the proposed Fyshwick Waste Recycling Facility, to be located so close to residences in several of the Inner South suburbs of Narrabundah, Griffith and Kingston and the retail/light industrial area of Fyshwick itself seems to go against what Canberra stands for.

The Fyshwick Waste Recycling Facility will adversely affect the nearby residents and business owners with the smell and noise and the increased traffic from garbage trucks will affect all Canberrans who "shop" at Fyshwick.
