Dear Sir/Madam

I am writing to you to express my strong objection to the proposed Materials Recovery Facility in Fyshwick.

I work for a company located in Fyshwick which trades 6 days a week. The proposed recycling facility in the above mentioned application introduces activity into the area that would have a detrimental impact on the existing commercial, wholesale & retail businesses in the area, including ours.

The traffic in the area is already rather congested throughout the day with the employees, consumers and large vehicles servicing the various businesses in the area. The additional 230 trucks each day this facility would attract, not to mention the additional cars from the employees of this facility, would create further delays and bottlenecks on roads not designed to cope with this kind of volume.

The potential health risks are also of great concern. The NSW EPA has assessed the Queanbeyan/Canberra area as having the highest reading of 2.5 particulates outside of Sydney already. Add increased diesel fumes concentrated along a singular route with continual heavy vehicle traffic and those numbers will only increase, creating increased difficulty for anyone suffering asthma or respiratory issues.

I believe this proposed facility would be greatly detrimental to the Fyshwick area and therefore request that the application for this facility is rejected.
