Dear assessment officers,

The proposed Materials Recovery Facility, Fyshwick (application number 201700053) is not an appropriate development for the Fyshwick business region. I have serious objections to this proposal for the following reasons:

- Increased potential for serious accidents from trucks on Ipswich Street
- Odour – this place is going to stink out business, consumers and staff that work in the adjacent area
- Idling trucks emitting diesel fumes
- Seriously slowing down traffic on Ipswich St
- Constant noise from the operations of the facility along with the cumulative noise from the adjoining ARS scrap metal, integral to the rail freight to Port Botany
