Block 23 Section 31 O'Malley

The Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) has received a number of community requests for more information about Block 23 Section 31 O'Malley, which is on the ACT Government's land release program for early 2018.

In response, the EPSDD project team invites you to attend a drop in information session to learn more about the government's land release plans for the site.
