Good afternoon,

I would like to put forward my submission against the proposed facility for a materials recovery facility in Fyshwick. As a long term resident of Narrabundah I am particularly concerned about the pollutants and air quality emitting from the proposed facility. This includes the increased emissions from the trucks accessing the facility. I have two chronic lung conditions that I feel would be compromised if this facility goes ahead.

On so many levels (traffic, health risks, vermin, odour, noise, fire risk etc.) the location of the waste recovery plant will compromise the prosperity of Fyshwick and seriously detract from its general amenity and that of the surrounding neighbourhood.

There must surely be other more suitable locations (eg Hume?) where the effects of an operation of the kind proposed would not be as destructive and affect existing residents.

I urge you to seriously consider alternative sites that would have less impact on residents and users of the very busy Fyshwick area.
