I would like to register my strong objection to the proposed recycling plant to be situated 200 metres from my business in Fyshwick.

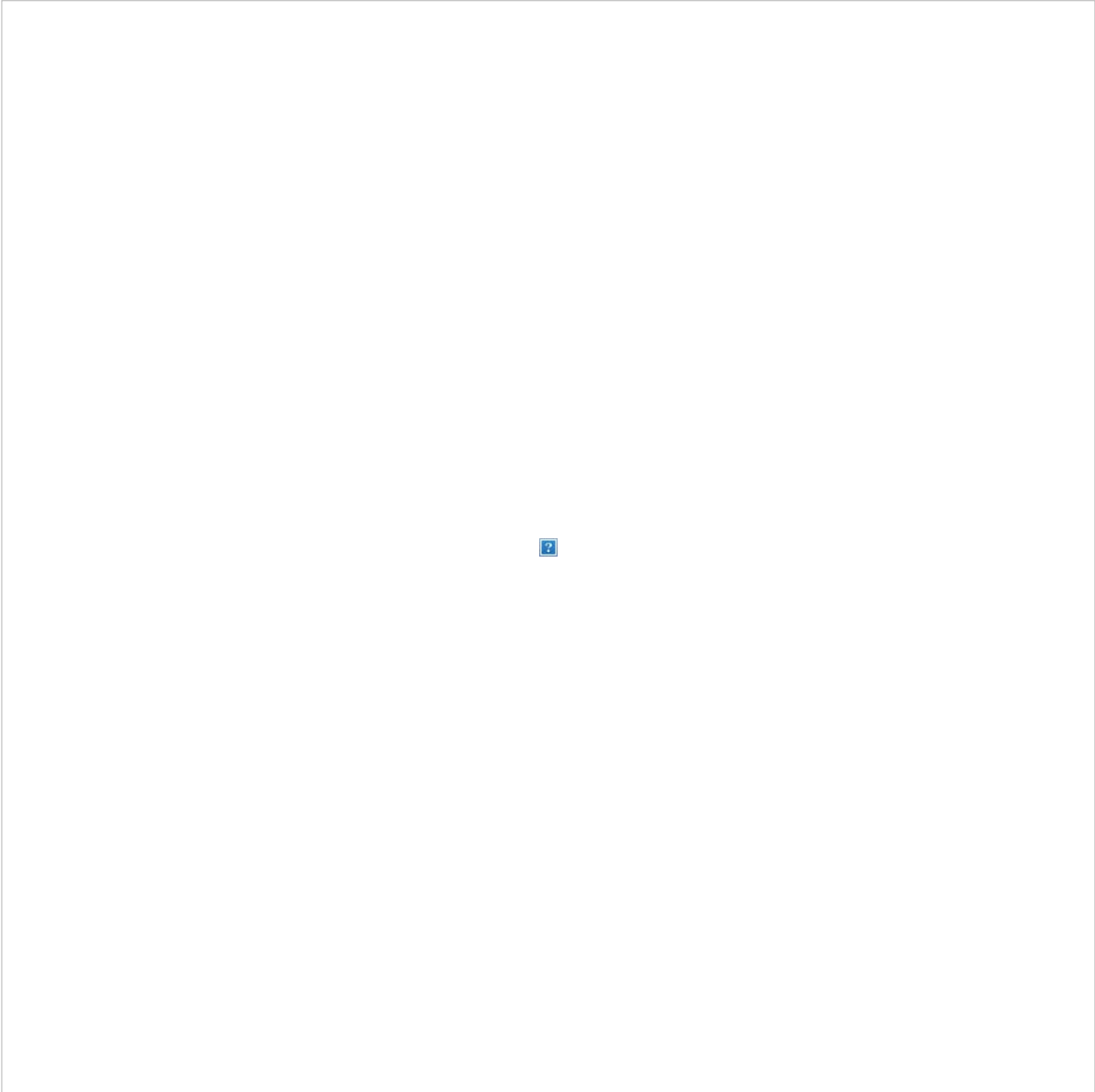
[REDACTED] relocated our offices to Ipswich Street in November 2015 because of its central location, easy access to the Canberra business district and the diverse business infrastructure that Fyshwick offers. It's becoming a very modern and vibrant part of Canberra. To locate a recycling plant in the middle of Fyshwick, only five kilometres from the heart of the nation's capital defies logic.

I drive past the Mugga Lane recycling plant on my way to work every day and can smell the plant for anything up to a kilometre away and to suggest that a new plant will be totally odourless is fanciful.

Traffic on Ipswich street during peak hour is heavy and in the afternoons can be backed up for half a kilometre down Ipswich Street as vehicles attempt to get onto Dairy Flat Road and the freeway. Add a few hundred trucks per day to this and we will have yet another traffic calamity.

I strongly oppose this facility being located in Fyshwick. It does not need to be located on prime land in the heart of the business district, next to shopping centres, a brewery, the foreshore and nearby residences.
