I am writing to express an objection to the proposed waste management facility in Fyshwick. The facility is an inappropriate development for a commercial area like Fyshwick; an area that has become a vital part Canberra's retail infrastructure.

I am a regular shopper at Fyshwick and am concerned that its amenity and environment will be detrimentally affected by such a facility.

I am also concerned for the potential side-effects of such a development on the viability of the businesses that i currently patronise. Specifically, some businesses may cease to trade due impacts including: :

- heightened and discouraging traffic levels (trucks especially), which are already at a 'busy' standard
- decreased air quality
- poor odour and noise levels
- increased fire risk; and
