I strongly oppose the proposed materials recovery facility at blocks 9 & 11 section 8 Fyshwick.

To be honest, I find this proposal completely ludicrous.

Waste management facilities belong in industrial areas as separate to any other activities as possible. As per the Mugga Lane and Mitchell facilities.

Whilst Fyshwick has light industrial, it does not even have much heavy industrial activity these days. It is essentially a warehousing, commercial and retail hub with a smattering of lifestyle businesses and activities, a pattern encouraged by the ACT government in recent times.
