Block 25 Section 31 O'Malley

Please note that the Office of Surveyor General (OSG) has publicly notified the ACT Government's intention to close a car park in O'Malley.

Any objections to the closure must be submitted to the OSG at the details below and not to this email address.

Notice of intention to close public road - O'Malley

Under the Public Roads Act 1902, notice is given that it is intended to close part of the road reserves known as Pindari Crescent adjacent to Blocks 3, 23 and 24 Section 31 Division of O'Malley. The site has been prepared by the Suburban Land Agency for sale by auction/ballot in accordance with the Government's Indicative Land Release Program.

The decision has been made to amalgamate the blocks and the car park servicing it into one block, due to the potential value of the tree group located on the block and in order to accommodate a larger parcel of developable land for the potential purchaser. The Suburban Land Agency has undertaken the necessary traffic investigations, including usage statistics and advice from Roads ACT, and is satisfied that the road closure will have minimal impact on surrounding roads.

The notifiable instrument showing the area affected is available for inspection during business hours at the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate, 16 Challis Street, Dickson ACT and on the website (<http://www.legislation.act.gov.au/ni/2018-1/notification.asp>).
