Dear Members,

As a resident of south Canberra I strongly oppose the proposed waste recycling facility being located on Section 8 Block 9&11 Fyshwick.

My objection is based on the following:

- The waste terminal site is in a IZ2 area which prohibits rail use at Block 11 Section 8, the Territory land.
- I do not want the change of purpose for the site to be made a IZ1 area.
- The resulting dramatic increase in traffic movements and traffic congestion in the Fyshwick area.
- The extremely negative impact on the business and environment not only in the immediate Fyshwick vicinity, but also in adjacent areas such as The Fyshwick Markets, Kingston Foreshore, Griffith and Narrabundah.
- The accumulative health effects from the increased diesel exhaust emissions from plant and delivery vehicles, dust emissions, and the general fine particle emission are of an immense concern to the public and should be fully appreciated and understood by all in Government considering this proposal.
- The threshold levels are unknown of such environmental contamination that cause or exacerbate the following,
  - Cancer,
  - Allergic and Hypersensitive reactions
  - Asthma, & general respiratory distress, even premature death
  - General irritation of mucous membranesand there are numerous studies both in Australia and overseas showing the above adverse effects of such emission particles.
