

SURVEY PRACTICE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

OUTCOMES

30 April 2008

The committee endorsed the Continual Professional Development (CPD) Guidelines subject to no significant unresolved issues being raised after discussion of this issue at the Canberra Division of ISA CPD seminar on 3 May 2008.

The Committee endorsed the draft MoU subject to the Action Items below and that no significant unresolved issues are raised after discussion on this issue at the Canb Division of ISA CPD seminar on 3 May 2008.

23 July 2008

The Committee agreed that (interim) Chief Surveyor Survey Practice Guidelines should be tabled with the Legislative Assembly to avoid the possibility of the old directions being revoked without a replacement. Subject to industry consultation, the committee members agreed that it would be highly desirable for the thorough review of these directions to be completed before the end of the current financial year.

4 September 2009

The committee endorsed changes to guidelines 1, 2 and 4 which can now be published

20 July 2010

The committee endorsed changes to the Survey Practice Directions including:

- Need to show easements on identification surveys
- Include revised supervision provisions in line with NSW (with minor changes)
- Details on Community Titles
- Addition of updated 'standards and specifications for Unit Plans'.

22 June 2011

The committee agreed that the Survey Practice Directions, Standards and Specifications for Unit Plans and Standards and Specifications for Deposited Plans should be separate documents.

7 December 2011

The committee agreed to the general approach to defining Datum Ground Level however issues regarding public access to this information and management of Intellectual Property were deferred for consideration at the next meeting.
