Dear sir/madam,

I write to register strong opposition to the proposed establishment of a waste transfer facility in Fyshwick.

As a resident of Kingston and Griffith for the past 11 years, I have watched Fyshwick grow from a mainly industrial area to a mixed-use suburb with a range of shopping and leisure amenities (most recently highlighted by the opening of Capital Brewing and the Bloc climbing facility).

The proposed waste facility goes against this positive trend of development in the Fyshwick area and runs the risk of introducing a disruptive daily commute of garbage trucks and significant negative waste externalities - odour and pollutants.

In addition, the proposed facility's negative aspects would also significantly infringe on inner South residents - impact reporting has indicated odour, traffic and pollutant effects on residents in Narrabundah, Griffith and Kingston from the proposed facility.

It is without doubt that facilities such as that proposed need to exist - but the ACT has plenty of usable land that is not within impact distance of nearby heavily populated suburbs and the proposer's desire to place the facility in Fyshwick for convenience does not justify the inconvenience it would cause for local residents, and the halting of positive development in Fyshwick.
