– EIS Application 201700053**


Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Environment Impact Statement (EIS) prepared for the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) in Fyshwick.

Our concerns are focussed on the safe and efficient operation of aircraft arriving and departing Canberra Airport.

Following a review of the documents available on your website in regard to the EIS, Canberra Airport notes that the MRF building will be fully enclosed and that, most importantly, there will be no open waste stored outside the MRF building unless it is containerised in waterproof shipping containers; thereby negating the risk of attracting more birds to the area.

On this basis, Canberra Airport has no objection to the proposal. We look forward to reviewing the Development Application when lodged to be reassured that bird attraction risk is appropriately mitigated when the MRF is operational.
