Dear Sir/Madam

As a longstanding resident of Griffith and customer of various businesses in Fyshwick and the Fyshwick Markets, I wish to express my opposition to the proposed redevelopment of the old Shell depot as a waste recycling/transfer station.

I am concerned that the establishment of such a facility in an inner suburb will have serious negative consequences for the residents of nearby suburbs and the businesses that operate in and around Fyshwick. These negative consequences include:

- a significant increase in heavy vehicle movements in and around Fyshwick and roads leading to Fyshwick which would have the effect of worsening traffic congestion and increasing the risk of accidents involving cars and pedestrians;
- noise and atmospheric pollution;
- potential for odours from the facility impacting nearby residential suburbs, depending on weather conditions;
- health risks from increased diesel emissions from garbage trucks; and
- increased greenhouse gas emissions from other road users caught up in the congestion caused by the movement off those vehicles.

As a fairly regular customer of several businesses in Fyshwick, I am also concerned that the adverse consequences of this facility, if it were to proceed, might lead to people being reluctant to patronise them, resulting in business closures.
