I wish to register my opposition to the proposed waste transfer station.

Logic would dictate that such a facility should be located distant from residential areas, both to avoid the possibility of noxious and/or objectionable odours, and probably more important to avoid increasing the number of large trucks on what are already congested roads. Canberra Avenue is already one of Canberra's busiest arterial roads.

I would suggest that the industrial area of Hume would be a much better fit for this purpose; it is more remote for residential areas, it is closer to existing waste management facilities and the impact from increased truck use would be far less than at Fyshwick.
