Lyneham oval is rarely used by the Lyneham residents. I would only see the occasional dog walker using it. The only people who use it are the students from Lyneham Public and Brindabella Christian College. By allowing the car park to remain and open to the community, it would allow greater use. If it was closed, traffic would become dangerous and parking in Lyneham would become unbearable as staff from Brindabella would need to park in the surrounding streets and students would need to walk through significant traffic. I am also aware that adjusted parking arrangements have been made available to Lyneham Public on Brigalow St due to the dangerous nature of walking children to school. I personally supported this action as a sensible arrangement for schools.

**Comment on Draft Plan Amendment 12 – Brindabella Christian College carpark –
Lyneham Section 41 part Block 23 (DPA-12)**

SUPPORT FOR THE AMENDMENT

Dear team

I am writing in support of the **Draft Plan Amendment 12** which, in my view, is consistent with the ACT Government's long term pragmatic and common sense approach to the management of the Lyneham neighbourhood.

Comments are due by 17 April 2026.

Originally, in 2009, the extensions to Brindabella Christian College infrastructure were funded by the Rudd Federal Government's 'Building an Education Revolution' program which was designed, in part, to urgently respond to the Global Financial Crisis of the preceding year.

Since then, patterns of car ownership of senior students have changed increasing the demand for space for car parking at the school, perhaps in unexpected ways. In this context, the use of the land adjacent to the new buildings for parking is perfectly understandable.

Alternatives to the current approach of a car park for the school are not desirable. Increased competition for car parking at the Lyneham shops, increased traffic in and around the Lyneham Primary School and increased parking on residential side streets would be the inevitable outcomes: - all undesirable from the point of view of local residents, I would have thought.

Should the land for the car park have been reserved for other urban uses? Actually, it is very rare to see *anyone* using the adjacent land for *any* purpose at *any* time (maybe very occasionally some guys on a Saturday afternoon kicking a soccer ball, but there is still plenty of room for that on the available land). So, it is really not the case that the amenity of the remaining land is diminished by the ongoing presence of the car park.

Finally, my attention to this matter was raised by a letterbox drop made by the 'Lyneham Community Association'. The campaign letter drafted by this organisation 'Save Lyneham Oval' is mainly devoted to the re-litigation of old issues using inflammatory language. This seems unreasonable and unhelpful. In fact, there must be a question

mark about the authority for this organisation's campaign since it is not clear that the Executive Committee has been elected consistent with the organisation's (very detailed) constitution: at the very least, the Association does not appear to have been transparent about the processes leading to the installation of the current Executive Committee.

In any case, its time to move on.

Dear Territory Plan and Coordination Team,

We write to **support** the amendment to the Territory Plan to allow the car park for Brindabella College. At the outset we advise that we are not affiliated with the College; our sons went through the Lyneham Primary and High School system many years ago. We do walk along the path which borders the open space to the Lyneham shops regularly.

We are not in favour of losing any open space in established suburbs and also acknowledge that the previous owner of Brindabella was presumptuous in regard to the regulations about establishment and continued use of the car park. Having said that we make the following points:-

- The area between Brindabella and the Primary school is effectively regarded as school grounds by surrounding residents during school hours.
- Over the last 50 years, we have observed that the use of the whole area outside school hours is quite minimal consisting mainly of family groups enjoying some recreation.
- We are not aware of any regular organised sporting or other activity that occurs requiring a large area.
- Community use is therefore sparse.

- The Lyneham Community Association has not identified any community use that would be lost specifically by the Brindabella car park and we cannot foresee any either. In other words, the area has little or no alternative use considering the availability of extensive open space between the two schools and across the Creek at the High School.
- Lyneham High has two car parks which are overflowing and the smaller Primary School has limited parking. Contrary to the Lyneham Community Association submission, we see nowhere else for Brindabella cars to park as restricted street parking progressively spreads outward from Northbourne Avenue.
- To us, Brindabella Christian College is an economic and cultural asset to the area and seems able to share the playing fields with the Primary School.

We suggest it would be dog-in-the-manger to not approve the car park and we urge the team to continue with the approval of the variation to the Territory Plan.

I believe this carpark should remain open.
The parking spaces it provides on a school day reduces the congestion on the surrounding streets, which have very limited parking availability. It improves traffic flow on Brigalow street and the surrounding streets as people are not stopping for setdown/pickup and provides a safe place for students of both Brindabella Christian College and Lyneham Primary school to be dropped off the main street.
In addition to providing parking for the families and staff at Brindabella, this carpark also provides an additional parking option for the staff and families of Lyneham primary school which has extremely limited parking options available, and provides additional community parking options.
There are a number of regular users who park in this location and walk the short distance to the public tram for the remainder of their commute. There are also the users of the public oval space - given the limited time parking that is available in the second smaller carpark, the main carpark provides parking spaces for those who are using the oval for training and recreational purposes.
