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Dear Sir,

I have been examining the nature of the proposal to permit the CRS Waste Transfer Facility in Fyshwick. I understand the proposal envisages approximately 400 heavy vehicle movements per day. With Canberra set to grow and at its current rate this will double in traffic load in approximately 30 years. The current load is not acceptable and a doubling would cause a significant deterioration of life quality for people in the area. The second issue is the zoning of the site. A site which permits heavy industrial activity as proposed should be situated on a heavy industrial zoning region. That is not the case for the proposed site. While rail access may be an important consideration it should not overturn the principles of good planning and governance.

I am very strongly opposed to the site being used for the proposed purpose. It must be relocated to a site away from other light commercial and retail activity. It will be disastrous to adjacent businesses who will not be compensated.
