I most strongly oppose this proposal for 5 reasons as follows:

1. It will dramatically increase air pollution of an area which is dense with popular eating, retail and employment facilities
2. It is ridiculous to rationalize this facility by importing waste from NSW
3. There would be an increased risk of fire as demonstrated by the recent blaze in a nearby recycling yard
4. The increased traffic density and pollution would be totally out of character with the green urban vision for Canberra to which the territory government has been committed.
5. Despite protestations to the contrary, it would seem to be a step toward the implementation of a 'waste to energy' proposal which research has shown can bring increased cancer risks to residential neighbourhoods.
